KINDERGARDEN AND PRIMARY WING

Learning should be a pleasant experience and the little Josephites learn through fun. Their readiness to ideate, create and display is commendable. Learning by doing enhances their skills required for being







competent in their lives. Our School propagates the philosophy of 'Learning by Doing'. The Pre-primary section celebrates it as special days according to their given themes. The themes included are colours, fruits, vegetable etc. For Grade 1 & 2 CCA activities like clay modelling, fingerprinting, picture talk, memory test, fancy dress, folk dance, drawing, storytelling etc conducted for KG. Various vibrant activities were conducted in kindergarten as a part of promoting holistic development. Learning these colours allows them to recognise significant visual hues such as red as a code for danger and the meaning behind traffic lights. To teach an abstract concept like

colour, various hands-on activities were conducted with various developmentally appropriate activities in order to expose the children to the wonders of the universe

HIGH SCHOOL



Academic and co-curricular activities go hand in hand giving prior preference to academics. Languages are mainly concentrated on developing LSRW skill in the students. To enhance subject enrichment some of the activities conducted in languages are elocution, essay writing, role play, debate, calligraphy, singing (patriotic songs), spell bee, story writing and poem

reciting and JAM sessions. ILM faculty help the students to develop their communications skills.



Maths Club helps students to enhance their math skills, this club helps students to grasp mathematical concepts better through activities like puzzles, shortcuts in calculations etc.

Practical and activity-based teaching will be done in science. Apart from Lab activities various programmes like plantation, health

and hygiene, seminars, orientations were conducted by eco club. A short film taken on the theme "Energy conservation "got selected in State level this year.



In social science apart from academics, mock assemblies were conducted and regularly students were updated with currents affairs through quiz.

Art Integrated Learning has been a hallmark of the school as per the norms of the CBSE. Art and craft faculty play a major role in

teaching the techniques to draw various figures and help them to complete their projects successfully.

Competitions and academic activities that go beyond the textbooks and the classrooms encourages a healthy and competitive spirit and effective communication skills in the students. The activities are conducted at classroom level, school level and interhouse level.



SPOKEN ENGLISH



To maintain discipline in English usage, the introduction of **ILM** actively showcases students' talents through skill expo boards, resolution letter boxes, debates, speech training, role plays, power books, and a special and exclusive coaching was provided on phonetics for improving students' pronunciation and accent resulted in helping

them to overcome mother tongue influence in their interaction and developed an aesthetic style in interacting in English.

CODING PROGRAMME

To meet the needs of students there have been certain changes in the education policy. By realizing the importance first hand we adopted coding in our school. The computer faculty were specially trained by the professionals in coding as a result, number of students can learn this skill to thrive in the future.

CBSE Results March 2023-24(Class X th)



We feel elated to share that the students of class X, who appeared for Secondary School Examination held by CBSE for session 2023-24, passed with flying colours. The total number of students who appeared were 95 and the school gained cent percent results. .66 scored first class,23 students with second class and 6 students with third class grading. T. Vaishnavi stood in first place with 94%. The credit for this achievement goes to the supporting management, tireless efforts of the students, teachers and dedicated parent community.

SCHOOL ASSEMBLIES



Theme based school assemblies which are conducted class wise provide students with opportunities to actively participate and showcase their abilities.
